

## **JI - STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

### *Category P*

All student behavior must be based on respect and consideration for diversity and the rights of others.

Students are expected to behave at all times in a manner appropriate to good citizenship. This includes respectful use of language and behavior that avoids ethnic, racial and sexual stereotypes and biases. Insults or sarcasm shall not be directed toward other students or educators.

Student rights and responsibilities shall be published in the parent-student handbook, a copy of which shall be made available in alternative format or other languages upon request. Students are expected to know and respect the rules and regulations of the school as set forth by these policies, the parent-student handbook, and the administrators of the District. Parents and guardians have a responsibility to assist their child in reviewing and understanding the parent-student handbook. The parent-student handbook shall be provided to all students annually at the opening of school and to those students who enroll during the course of the school year. Student disciplinary procedures shall be implemented pursuant to the provisions of Board Policy JICD.
