**XI. NON-PUBLIC SESSION: RSA 91 – A: 3 II (c) and 91 – A: 2 I (b)**

*Motion was made by Peg Pinkham and seconded by Christine Kenneway to enter into non-public session to act upon a matter or matters referenced in RSA 91 – A: 3 II (c) and 91 – A: 2 I (b) at 8:46 pm. Vote was 5:0. Roll call was taken.*

Ms. Pinkham said that the Budget Committee had asked her if the Warrant Article could be explained in two parts but Ms. Kenneway replied that it couldn't be done that way since collective bargaining was not done that way.

Mr. Tanguay reported on the situation with the student with asthma requesting specific bus drop-off/pick up. He said that Fremont could not be held liable. Ms. Lewis said that she sent Ms. Boucher a letter and that the Guidance Department would call Ms. Boucher so she could discuss the matter with Sanborn.

A parent conference issue regarding Lisa Martel was discussed after Mr. Marston reviewed the problem she had with considering a 10-minute conference an inadequate amount of time to meet with middle school teachers. Mr. Marston said that she spoke with her, agreeing in part that perhaps 10 minutes was not enough time to meet with 4 teachers to discuss her child's progress. The middle school team agreed to schedule a time at 7:30 AM to meet with her.

Ms. Lewis said that it would be necessary to make sure that a half day was in the calendar next year for conferencing.

Ms. Kenneway talked about another issue about parents feeling like they will only get a response if they copy the School Board members when they send email to the administration.

Ms. Pinkham mentioned that she got a letter today from the SAU that was postmarked November 3, 2008. Mr. Tanguay said that usually the SAU holds any mail addressed to the School Board and distributes it at Board meetings but they can notify members if/when mail arrives for members too. Ms. Kenneway said that she wouldn't necessarily check the SAU for mail since she would not expect there to be any for individual Board members.

The School Board discussed the NESDEC superintendent and administration models.
